Omicron Variant – Local Response

Dear parents and carers

Mrs Siedle has outlined the Trust's response to the new COVID-19 variant Omicron and I am writing to add further detail on how in the immediate term, this affects our local plans here at St Thomas More as directed by local guidance:

After School Activity Clubs

Effective immediately, after school Activity Clubs are cancelled until further notice. Please note that the chargeable After School and Breakfast Club facilities remain available in the usual way.

Due to the size of the Key Stage 2 cohort (Years 3; 4; 5 and 6) and the need to restrict the number of attending parents, we are limiting places to Year 6 and those of the following musicians across the Key Stage – Barritone; Cello; French Horn; P-Bone; Trumpet and Violin.

If you would like to attend a performance then it is <u>essential</u> that you call the school office to prebook a place. Attendance is strictly limited to 1 family member only. Please avoid an uncomfortable situation where additional family members would be turned away on the day which I appreciate is in contrast to our usual flexibility.

We ask that you take a Lateral Flow Test before attending a performance, that you wash or sanitise your hands regularly and that unless exempt, you wear a face covering whilst on our premises. Seating will be arranged in a socially-distant manner and we ask that you remain in your seat for the duration of your stay and observe social distancing from others at all other times.
