Illness

Can I please ask you to be vigilant of the 3 key symptoms of COVID-19 which remain:

- a temperature of 37.8 degrees or higher;
- a new continuous cough;
- a change to, or loss of taste/smell.

Children should not attend school until they have had a PCR test if they display any of these symptoms.

Please also note that the most commonly reported symptoms associated with the dominant Delta variant include headache; sore throat; fatigue and cold-like symptoms.

If you have any concerns or are unsure if you should send your child into school, please contact the office who will be able to help.
